



## **Policy for Dedham Art Association Exhibits**

(as of 4-5-17)

- ❖ Two-dimensional fine arts categories accepted include drawing, painting, pastel, or multi-media. Reproductions, digital work, photography, and three-dimensional work are not eligible for exhibiting. Special exhibits/sales may be the exception.
- ❖ Please attempt to exhibit artwork that is original work by the artist (e.g., from nature, real life, from the artist's imagination or the artist's own photo.) The execution must be that of the artist alone.
- ❖ Finishing and Hanging
  - White or off-white mats or muted colors that complement the artwork; inner mats may be colored.
  - Work must be framed except for wrapped canvases which should be finished on all sides.
  - Work must be wired for hanging.
  - Plexiglas or styrene instead of glass should be used on work larger than 24" height or width.
- ❖ Subject matter should be suitable for general audiences.
- ❖ For judged exhibits, artwork must not have been exhibited in previous judged DAA shows.
- ❖ Artwork created in a class or workshop is not eligible for judged exhibits.
- ❖ The Dedham Art Association receives 20% commission on all sales. For most shows, entries may be listed as not for sale (NFS.)
- ❖ The Dedham Art Association reserves the right to reject work that does not meet the requirements of this policy.
